The State Prison.

The Jackson Citizen says: Thirteen convicts were received during the month of February, and twenty-nine during January. Six were committed for treason, one for breaking into a dwelling house in the first intent to commit larceny, one for larceny in dwelling house in day-time, one for murder in the second degree, one for conspiracy and obtaining property under false pretenses, one for burglary and larceny, one for seduction and one for adultery. Three were sent for one year, six for two years, one for one year, and nine months, one for three years, and one for ten years.

Sixteen were discharged during the month, against twenty-one during the month of January, as follows: Edward Newsom, George Baker, Major L. Smith, Luther J. Part, John Douglass, Thomas Hough, Henry Ed. McClellan, Thomas L. Winters, Elmer Hall, Joseph Miller, Augustus De Saipp, Edward H. Benedict, Driggs Garrison, Charles Swanson, Lorenzo P. Cole, George Gerasas.

Terence Birmingham was pardoned, and James H. Allen committed suicide.

There are 63 convicts now in prison, against 62 at the beginning of the month.
