Clearing-Home System.

Special attention has been called to the Clearing-Home system by the present for perhaps we ought rather to say the (2) financial emergency. The clearances of the banks have figured more prominently in this crisis than in any preceding monetary emergency.

The principle of commercial convenience, amounting to necessity, which called banks into existence underlies the Clearing-Home system. Only a very small percentage of the drafts and checks drawn against deposits are presented at the counter of the bank in which the funds are kept.

Our Currency. The system by which currency is now supplied in the United States is in most respects admirable and with some modifications which experience has suggested, or which suggest themselves, it will become the best system that the world has ever known.

That deficiency is the absence of any present provision for contraction and expansion with the fall and rise of the internal exchanges of the country at different seasons of the year.

This deficiency in our currency system is too well understood by all classes to need any elaboration in proof of its existence. No business man can have failed to observe that however abundant currency may be in summer, as soon as the cotton crop of the South and the grain crop of the West begin to move in to market, the movement of these crops diverts the currency from other uses.

It is putting it very simply to say that a large part of the currency which is now in circulation is being used for the purpose of paying for the necessities of life.
