TO BUILD NEW BUILDINGS FOR WOMEN AT PRISON FARM.

The Detroit News of Friday stated that the Detroit House of Correction has decided to erect new buildings for women at the prison farm. The colony for women will be built on land in Northville township and will accommodate 288 prisoners and its cost is estimated at \$700,000. The new colony will consist of eight cottages of the English type which will surround an administration building, and included in the group will be a hospital with detention wards, a power house and quarters for matrons and other branches of the institution.

It is planned to begin active construction work about April 1st and to complete the job by next fall. Conditions at the prison farm and at the prison in the city for the accommodation of women prisoners have been very unsatisfactory to the prison warden for some time, and it was finally decided to provide adequate quarters.

Under the plans, drawn by Albert Kahn, architect, the administration building will contain offices for the superintendent and assistant superintendent, a large visiting room and commissary, receiving and dressing rooms, singer, print and Berillon room, a welfare office and a medical examination room. It will be possible to place newly-arrived inmates in quarantine or under observation for two weeks. At the end of that period they will be classified and housed in one of the cottages.

The cottages will be far enough apart to permit of complete segregation of the various groups. In each cottage two matrons will be in attendance. Each cottage will have its own dining room and kitchen and reception room. A plot of ground, large enough for recreational purposes, will be made home-like in appearance by flower gardens and lawns.

In the rear of each cottage will be a workshop consisting of lumber yards, carpentry factories and basket making rooms. Heat for all the buildings will be supplied from a central power plant. Adjoining to the administration building will be a large ship-shaped windmill as well as a small one.

The prison, the officials say, will be of an unusually beneficial design, being entirely separated from the town and the vicinity.

What's in lumber will not have the usual bad appearance, they will be so constructed as to be seen by all, be it of benefit the management by the men now general at the House of Correction farm. They will be finished in aluminum.

One of the distinctive features of the prison will be the opportunity it will afford for segregation of inmates, considered one of the most important phases of correctional work.

As the prison population increases, additional cottages may be built on the tract.

DECLARES MACCABEE MERGER NOT LEGAL.

L. T. Hanks, state insurance commissioner, Tuesday filed an answer to the state supreme court to the petition of the Maccabees and the Ladies of the Maccabees for a writ of mandamus to compel him to approve their proposed consolidation.

The insurance commissioner in his answer alleges that the ladies organization did not approve the amalgamation by the required two-thirds vote. statutes. All other factors, however, have been disregarded, he set forth, because of his belief that the vote by the ladies' organization was so patently illegal.




