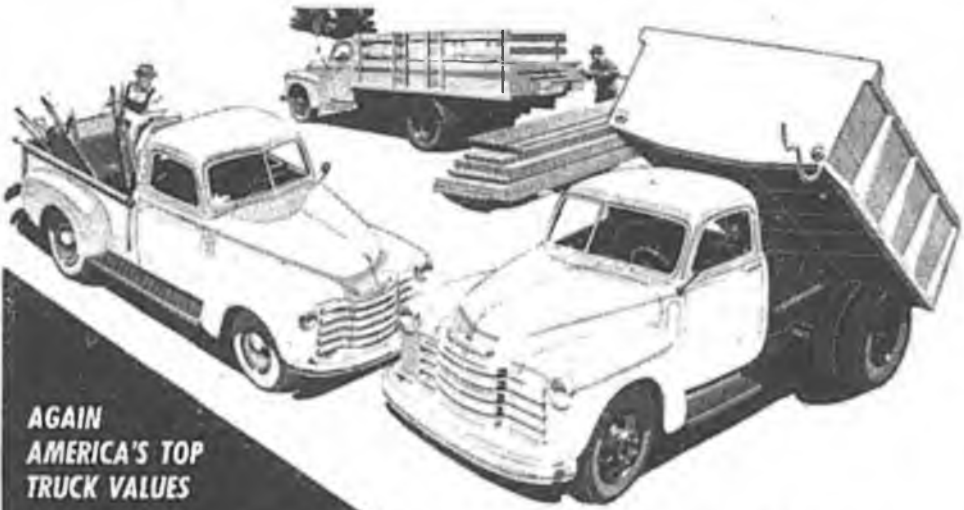

**New MSC Division To Group Studies in Conservation**  
Michigan State College will install a new Division of Conservation July 1 in the School of Agriculture, according to an announcement by Pres. John A. Hannah. Research, teaching and extension activities in conservation, which have been scattered through several other departments, will be drawn together in the new division. Prof. Paul A. Herbert, present forestry department head, will direct the division, which will include departments of conservation, fisheries and wildlife, forestry, and food utilization. Pres. Hannah, in announcing the new division, said, "The State Board of Agriculture, in authorizing the new division, was motivated by the growing interest and importance of the conservation of our natural resources for the well-being of Michigan and the nation."

"Cancer is a personal affair. You are the only person who can protect you against cancer. Some cancer is preventable and most cancer is curable if you get to your physician in time. Go to your physician for periodic physical examinations, and go to him immediately in between times if any of the seven signs of cancer appear." That is what State Health Commissioner Albert F. Heustis says in the March issue of "Michigan Public Health," which he holds April as Cancer Control Month in Michigan. The seven signs which may mean cancer and which call for immediate examination by a doctor are: 1. Any sore that does not heal. 2. Redness about the edges of a sore. 3. Swelling about a sore. 4. Discharge from a sore. 5. Change in the color of the skin. 6. Change in the shape of the skin. 7. Change in the texture of the skin. Heustis states: "These facts and others about cancer control and how to organize for cancer control in the local community are contained in the March issue of 'Michigan Public Health,' official bulletin of the Michigan Department of Health.
