Transcription Key

Italics: Surnames in italics do not appear on the grave marker. These are maiden names that have been added to enhance the transcription.

Parentheses: Information in parentheses does not appear on the grave marker. When possible, the full death date and death location have been added in parentheses to enhance the transcription.

Underlining: Information on the grave markers has occasionally been determined to be incorrect. The corrected date appears underlined within the parentheses.

Question Mark [?]: Indicates an incomplete marker. The year of death or death date has not been inscribed.

Tilde [~]: Surnames proceeded by this symbol have been found with various, phonetically similar spellings. The spelling given is just an approximation of the actual name.

Slash [/]: Some surnames appear in different records with varying spellings (for example, Stewart / Stuart); other surnames have been Americanized over time (for example, Javorski / Jenners).
